What is a Master Plan?

Alamo Township has begun a master plan update. According to the Michigan Planning Enabling Act (Public Act 33 of 2008), a master plan addresses future land use and establishes goals and priorities for the community over the next 20-years. It includes descriptive maps, demographic information, a land use and zoning plan, and other narrative material. The master plan is an official document authorized by Michigan law that can be viewed as a blueprint for the Township's future.

Your Input Matters!

Community input is an integral part of the planning process, which will begin with a SURVEY and an OPEN HOUSE to collect input from residents and property owners. The Master Plan Open House will be held **Wednesday, May 22nd from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm and again from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm**. Please stop by anytime during these timeframes. This is a drop-in event, requiring a small amount of your time to give needed input to the draft Master Plan.

The Master Plan Survey will be available at the Open House, Township Hall, and through SurveyMonkey online. Your responses are anonymous, and the data will be reported in total by question for all surveys received. If you pick up a survey at the Township Hall (7901 North 6th Street, Kalamazoo, MI 49009), please return your completed survey there.
